DeWitt's Nick Flegler named NFL Way to Play Award recipient

DeWitt junior receiver and defensive back Nick Flegler has been selected the winner of the NFL's Way to Play High School Award.

Flegler was revealed as the Week 9 recipient of the award on the NFL Network on Saturday. In a partnership with Hudl, the award was created with NFL Legends to promote proper playing technique across all levels of football. Flegler was nominated by the DeWitt coaching staff and recognized for displaying exemplary football technique.

With Flegler being honored, DeWitt will receive a \$1,500 equipment grant through USA Football.

Flegler has been part of an 8-0 season for the Division 3 top-ranked Panthers and had his third interception this fall in their 52-0 district semifinal victory over Waverly. He entered that contest with 21 tackles for DeWitt.
